TMJ problems, salivary glands diseases, maxillofacial trauma (fractures), benign and malignant tumors and patient with craniofacial anomalies and orthognathic problems are also very common. There are so many cases that need major surgical interventions; however there is only minimal focus on these patients due to the small number of oral and maxillofacial surgeons. Some of the patients will travel to a different country for treatment, but there are still a large number of cases who can't do the same as they can't afford the costs of the surgery. This encouraged me to tackle this field in hope of helping my country and increasing the diversity of medical care.

Moreover, surgical difficulties are often encountered in general practice. Through this course, I hope to develop my skills in this field, so that I am better prepared for these inevitable events. And while the future demand for dentists is expected to continue its steady growth of the last two decades, many dental students consider pursuing a specialty.

In Special:

My study plan is to pursue a Master's degree in **Clinical Stomatology** at **YOUR UNIVERSITY**, with major **Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery** concentrating in diagnosis, treatment planning, and execution of treatment by combining orthodontics and oral/maxillofacial surgery to correct musculoskeletal, dento-osseous, and soft tissue deformities of the jaws and associated structures to treat any jaw imbalance and the resulting incorrect bite, which could adversely affect the cosmetic (esthetic) appearance as well as the proper functioning of the teeth.

Because, there are many patient in my country with many different types of abnormalities of the jaw structures that can result in facial deformity, skeletal class II, III and improper bite. These abnormalities in the jaws and facial bones may be congenital (present at birth) or developed during growth and development. They may also be acquired after birth as a result of hereditary, environmental influences, or

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trauma/illness to the face. According to that many symptoms may appear with these cases like difficulty chewing, or biting food, difficulty swallowing, chronic jaw or jaw joint (TMJ) pain and headache, excessive wear of the teeth, open bite, unbalanced facial appearance from the front, or side, facial injury or birth defects, receding chin, protruding jaw, inability to make the lips meet without straining, chronic mouth breathing and dry mouth, sleep apnea.

Moreover, during my work many cases faces me with maxillofacial trauma (fractures) with Le Fort I, II and III fractures (**Le Fort fracture of skull**).

Therefore, I am sure that I will gain basic and advanced knowledge and practical training in the management of facial fractures (Le Fort injuries) and Orthognathic problems Participating in Clinical Training within **Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery** Department, in the Faculty and medical / dental affiliated institutions under high qualified supervision, strong desire, high spirit, equipment's availability, and university support I am sure that I can get good achievements in my research project.

After obtaining my Master degree from China, I plan on returning to Yemen without hesitation to put all the principles I have obtained into practice and give all that I would have studied to help my country. One of the most important goals is to finish my study and come back with such knowledge that allows me to make a difference in my country. I will do my best to help the students of my university that I am a member of its Academic staff to improve their clinical skills with sound medical background.
